

Dress Code:

All dress expectations apply to campers, counselors, and parents attending camp. In order to maintain the intended atmosphere at all times, we ask that no one wear clothing that depicts anything that could be considered un-Christian or anything in poor taste. The Camp Director or Staff reserve the right to ask a camper to change their clothing if it is considered inappropriate. Thank you!

Girl's Clothing:

Girls should wear modest dresses and skirts. Sundresses, low necklines, or split skirts above the knees are not allowed. Knee-length culottes can be worn for activities. Gauchos or long shorts that are called culottes by some are not permitted. Pants are not permitted. Bathing suits should be one-piece. Please bring something to wear over your bathing suit to and from the pool.

Boy's Clothing:

Boys must wear long pants. Shorts, jams, and skinny jeans are not allowed. Athletic and sweat pants may be worn for activities. Net, half, or sleeveless shirts are not allowed.

Camp Schedule:

Monday:

Arrive before 5:00 p.m. in time for assignment of beds. You may be asked to move to accommodate all campers if you check in early.

Evening meal- 5:00 p.m.

Evening service- 7:00 p.m.

Evening devotions- 10:30 p.m. Lights out- 11:00 p.m.

Tuesday-Friday:

Breakfast- 8:30 a.m.

Morning service- 9:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Lunch- 12:00 p.m.

Girl's Swimming- 1:30 p.m.-3:00 p.m. (Boys other activities) Boy's Swimming- 3:30 p.m.-5:00 p.m. (Girls other activities)

Evening meal- 5:30 p.m.

Evening service- 6:30 p.m.

Evening devotions- 10:30 p.m. Lights out- 11:00 p.m.

Boys and girl's activities are separate except volleyball.

Activities include swimming, basketball, volleyball, foosball, ping-pong, pontoon boat rides, canoeing, etc. Schedule is tentative and can be changed. Snacks will be available after each activity and night services. Each child will need money for the Snack Bar and for the Special Offering at the end of Youth Camp.

Camp fee is \$125 per week, per camper (including Counselors).

No pictures are allowed in the pool area or dormitory. Cell phones of campers must remain with the counselor. No cell phone calls without permission from your Counselor. Please bring your Bible! Thank you and we look forward to having a great week in the Lord!!!
